Press Release 1/2012 of Central Committee of the Chin National Front

The Emergency Conference of the Chin National Front has been successfully convened from December 12-16, 2011, at Indo-Burma border. The Conference formed a Supreme Council of the Chin National Front with 21 members consisting Dr. Za Hlei Thang (Falam Township), Pu Lian Uk (Halkha Township), Pu Kip Kho Lian (Tonzang Township), Thang Nang Lian Thang (Teddin Township), Pu Zo Tum Hmung (Thantlang Township), Pu Benjamin Turing (Matupi Township), Pu Thang Ning Kee (Mindat Township), Pu L. Chhangte (Mizo), Pu Thomas Thang Nou (CNF), Pu Thang Yen (CNF), Pu H.C. Ral Hnin (CNF), and Dr. Lian Hmung (Expert), while people from Kanpalet Township, Paletwa Township, Asho Area, Thado Area and the Chin Women Organization have to send their respective representatives. The 4 Secretariats of the CNF's Central Executive Committee are directly included as members of the Supreme Council.

The Emergency Conference elected Dr. Za Hlei Thang, Pu Lian Uk, Salai Kip Kho Lian and Thang Nang Lian Thang each a one-year term rotating Chairman of the Supreme Council of CNF, Pu Zing Cung as Secretary-General, Pu Paul Sitha as Assistant Secretary-General 1 in charge of departments of Party and Alliance Affairs, Military Affairs, and Information and Publicity, Dr. Sui Khar, Assistant Secretary-General 2 in charge of departments of Foreign Affairs, Trade and Commerce, and Strategic Research, Pu Khua Uk Lian, Assistant Secretary-General 3 in charge of departments of Organizing Committee, Chin Public Affairs Committee, Finance and Revenue, and Dr. Salai Ngun Cung Lian, Col. Solomon, Pu Rokhawma, Pu Thet Ni, Salai Thla Hei, Salai Daniel Sakhong, Pu Sang Biak and Pu Lang Khan Pau are elected as members of the Central Executive Committee for the 5th Party Conference term. The Conference also elected Dr. Salai Ngun Cung Lian Chairman, and Pu Thang Yen and Pu Kha Pawng members of the Judicial Body for the 5th Party Conference term.

The Central Committee and the Central Executive Committee meetings were successfully held from December 19-21, 2011, and December 28-31, 2011, respectively. The meetings not only outlined the policies of the Party, strategies and tactics, but also formed different working committees and departments, laid out plans, assigned positions with responsibilities for the term of the 5th Party Conference.
